

Rose Sale 2022 Instructions for Ordering and Terms

Welcome to our 2022 Summer Rose Sale!

Thank you for supporting this non-profit plant preservation effort as we strive to assure the survival of a great collection of historic roses. We know you will recognize the rarity of what we offer this year, including many very old varieties that have not previously been available to purchase in North America. We urge you to give a home to some of these beauties and to become a curator of old roses.

TERMS OF OUR SALE

for Guardians of the Rose, you may begin sending orders at 10 am on Saturday, September 10th. All others may place orders on Sunday, September 11th at 10 am.

— Your order should contain the following:

1. Your name and preferred email address.
2. Names of requested roses in LIST form, not in sentence form.
3. A LIST of alternative selections to substitute. (*optional*)

— Once you have received an itemized invoice of

your order from Gregg, you may pay either by check to The Friends of Vintage Roses and sent to our Sebastopol address below, or on our Rose Sales page online, by clicking on the top most payment button. (Read the simple instructions on that page before clicking the Paypal “Buy” button. Your invoice email will provide instructions.

PLEASE note, we are sending an acknowledgement of the receipt of your order in person by email as soon as possible after it comes to us. This acknowledgement is not an invoice with the cost to pay on your order. We ask you kindly NOT to make payments until your final invoice is received. This avoids refunds through Paypal, and their charges for processing refunds. All orders will be processed in the order we receive them.

— Pickup of Plants in Sebastopol will take place on September 24, from 10 am to Noon, and from 1 until 3, and on September 25 from 10 am until Noon.

Pickup your roses at the garden of the Friends at 3003 Pleasant Hill Rd, Sebastopol, CA 95472.

Later dates for pickup can be arranged with the curator. IF YOU LIVE IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, you can place orders to be picked up at the home of

our treasurer in the City of Orange, in the Autumn. Check with us for our delivery schedule in October.

We cannot ship plants.
